Welcome to the launch of our Groovy Art Newsletter. Here we'll keep you posted on upcoming event news and views on events and the arts.

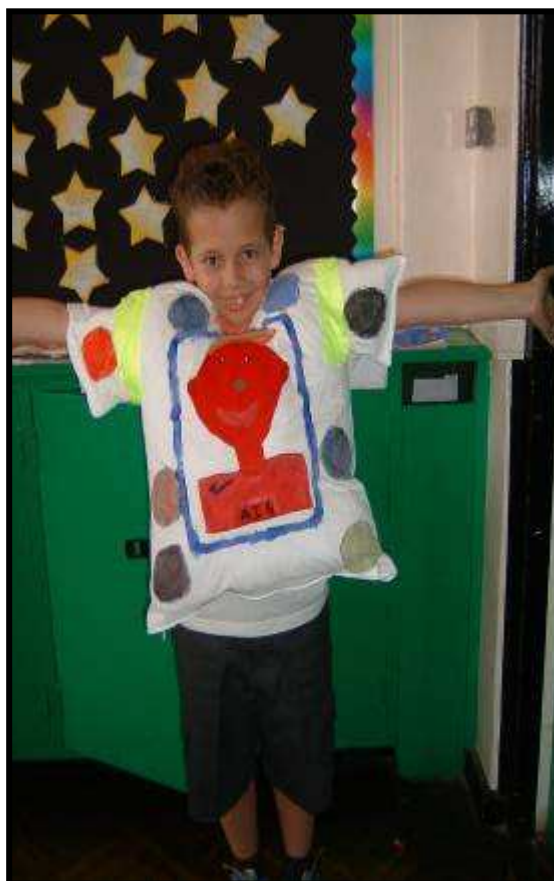
Groovy Art Workshops at Barham School delivered a series of workshops between 6th—10th October of fantastic art activities.

T-shirt cushion made by pupil exploring the journey of growing up.

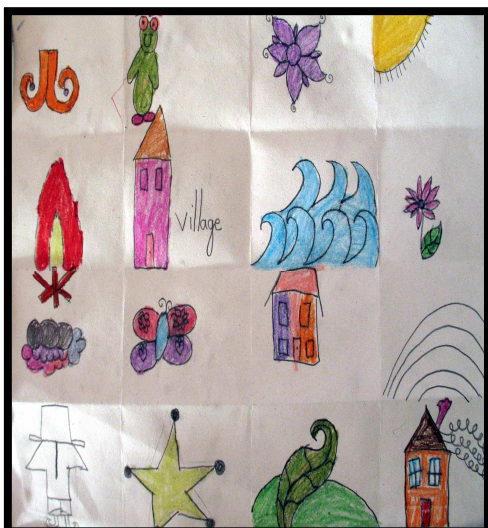
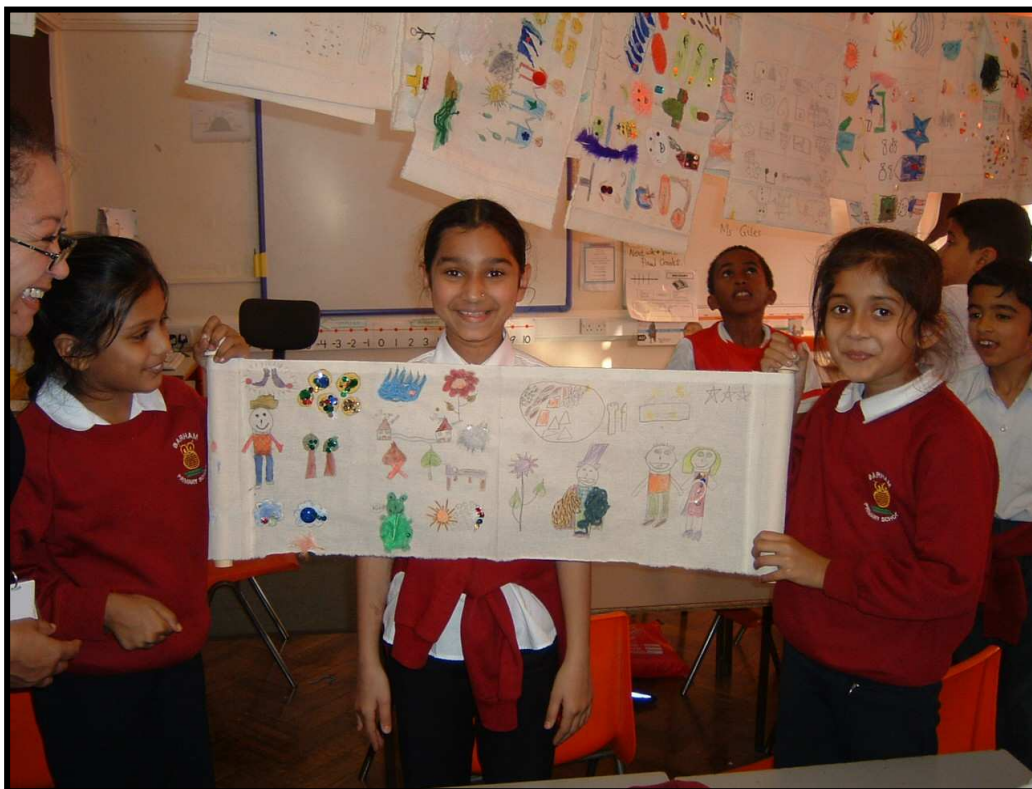
